3. Purpose of Processing Personal Data

Personal data is collected solely for the purpose of organising and reporting on the activities of the NEXT-UP Living Lab. This includes maintaining records of the number and categories of registered participants and analysing aggregated outcomes from the discussions held during the Living Lab events. No personal data will be used for other purposes.

4. Lawful Basis for Processing

Processing is based on public interest in scientific research (GDPR Art. 6.1.e, Art. 89) and voluntary informed consent (GDPR Art. 6.1.a).

5. Categories of Data Processed

We will collect and process basic contact and participation details: name, email address, stakeholder category (e.g. youth, academic, NGO, employer, policymaker), country, and





participation preferences (e.g. workshop attendance, willingness to join stakeholder pool). In addition, we will document the inputs provided during and after the workshops, such as discussion notes, ideas, or feedback. These contributions will be analysed and reported only in aggregated or anonymised form, so that no individual participant can be identified. No sensitive personal data (special categories under GDPR) will be processed.

6. Sources of Personal Data

Data is provided directly by participants via the registration form.

7. Recipients of Data

Data will only be processed by members of the NEXT-UP project consortium. It will not be disclosed outside the consortium or transferred outside the EU/EEA.

8. Storage and Retention

Data will be stored securely on Tampere University systems (protected by usernames, passwords, and MFA). Personal data will be retained until the end of the project (July, 2028) and then deleted unless further consent is obtained.

9. Data Subject Rights
