Faculty of health sciences, University of Primorska, has two collaborators on the 4Steps project with the corresponding roles:

The role of the University of Primorska, Faculty of health sciences is to lead the ICT-skills work package (WP4) and to participate in WP1 (Project setup), WP10 (Quality), WP11 (Dissemination and Exploitation) and WP12 (Management). Besides that, we are responsible to organize meeting on 12 and 13 September 2022 at our institution in Slovenia and collaborate with the quality assurance team.

WP1 - Preparation: Boštjan Žvanut and Patrik Pucer were present in the kick off meeting, where screening of the situation in ICT use in education by the Asian partner countries was performed. Accordingly, the plan of the training for the acquisition of ICT skills was developed for all Asian partners.

WP4 – ICT skills:

Two ICT skills trainings were designed and completed:

- Nam Dinh University of Nursing training, Nam Dinh, Vietnam (4 October 2021 – 15 February 2022), due to COVID-19 we decided to perform the training online. Hence, the workshop was redesigned and extended in order to be performed online. Both training were reported as successful (refer to the attached reports).

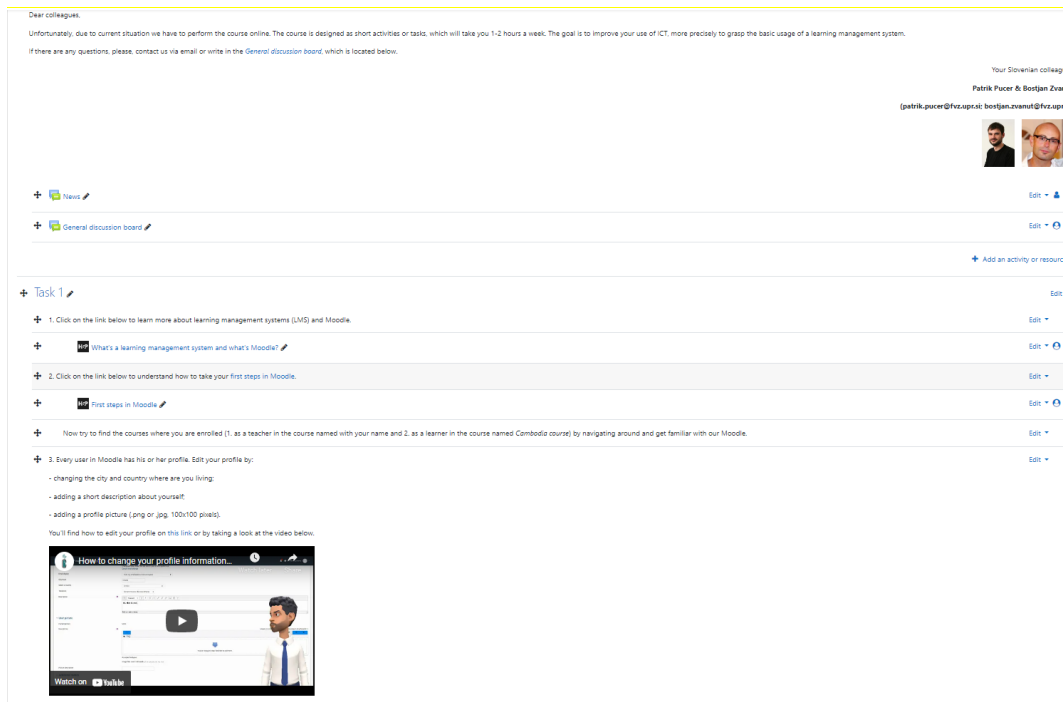


Figure 1: Excerpt of the online training with HIS RCAF and UHS

In May 2022, we started the training online with the Cambodian partners: HIS RCAF and UHS. The participants received completed three online tasks (please, refer to figure 1). As the COVID-19 restrictions were eased, we decided to continue our trainings on site in January 2023 (currently arranging).

Two types of trainings were designed for the purpose of the project:

- basic training in use of learning management system Moodle (for Cambodian partners)
- advanced training in the design and development of e-content (for Vietnamese partners)
