



ISEDA

The **ISEDA** project (Innovative Solutions to Eliminate Domestic Violence) is a 3-year Horizon Europe project (September 2022 – August 2025), which will develop innovative tools and solutions to combat and eliminate domestic violence. It will employ a holistic European approach based on the expertise of practitioners - police authorities, civil society organizations, researchers and the private sector, as well as important insights from victims.



More specifically, the ISEDA project will develop:



a chatbot, which will inform victims on ways to get help and assistance, as well as provide advice on how to gather court-proof evidence; alongside a data platform, which will record domestic violence trends



an interactive serious game for police officers, which will help them acquire skills to better assess domestic violence situations and provide adequate assistance to victims



perpetrator programmes, which could serve as a chance for positive change for those who perpetrate violence, increasing the quality of life of women and their children, of men themselves, and that of related families and communities



awareness raising campaigns and education programs to sensitize the general public, but also engage students, foster know-how on deconstructing toxic gender stereotypes and promote healthy relationships and zero tolerance to violence

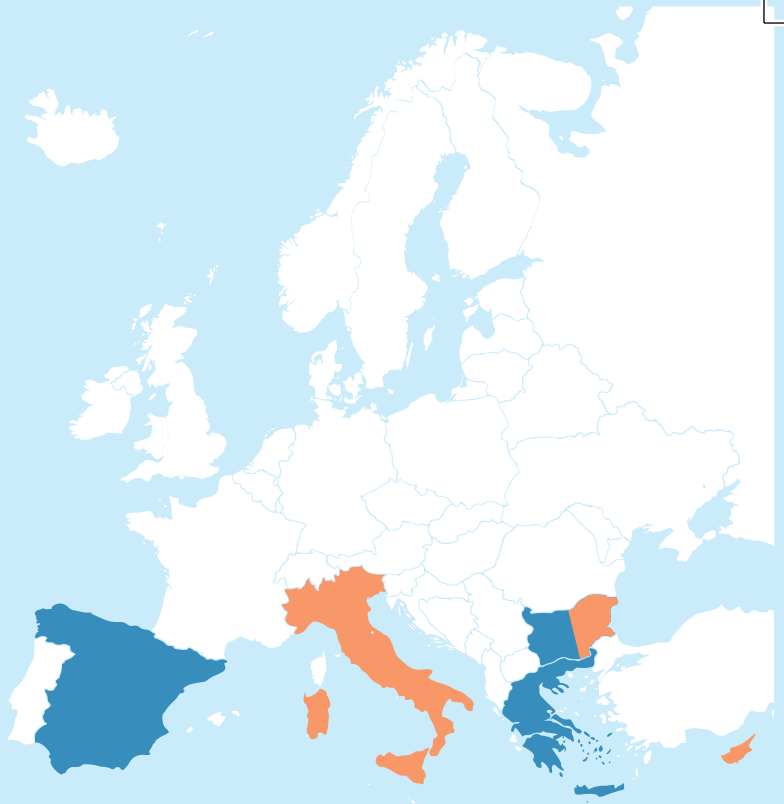
